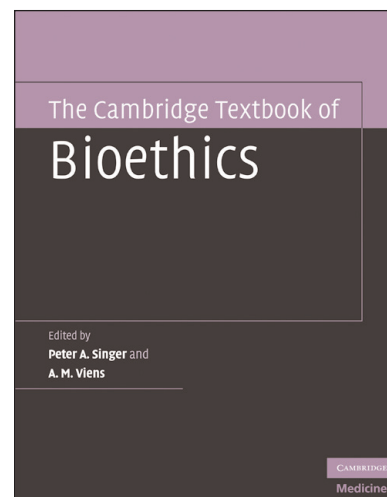


The Cambridge Textbook of Bioethics
